# Conference proceedings and submission of papers

#### **Abstracts**

The abstract submission deadline is 15 June 2008.

The maximum length of the abstract text is 250 words.

A registered participant can submit only two abstracts as a presenting author. Each presenting author must register for the conference by **10 September 2008** at the latest, in order for the abstract to be included in the abstract publication. All abstracts (MS Word files) should be sent as a single file by e-mail to <a href="mailto:breeding08@ifvcns.ns.ac.yu">breeding08@ifvcns.ns.ac.yu</a>, clearly indicating the corresponding author full name.

All accepted abstracts will be published in the Conference Book of Abstracts and they will be presented either as oral or poster presentation during the conference.

#### **Posters and oral presentations**

The maximum poster size allowed is 90 cm (width) x 120 cm (length). Adhesive tape and drawing pins will be provided. Speakers should hand in their Power Point Presentations (on CD, or USB memory device) to the organizers as early as possible after their arrival to the Conference venue.

#### **Manuscripts**

#### **About Novi Sad**

Novi Sad is the second largest city in Serbia and the capital of Vojvodina, the northern province of Serbia. Situated on the left bank of the river Danube, between Budapest and Belgrade, it is a treasured regional and cultural centre, famous for 18<sup>th</sup> century fortress on the right river bank as well as its attractive city beach and Fruska Gora Mountain. The city is industrial and trading centre with century's long educational and cultural tradition. Its multi-ethnic population is 300 000.

The conference language is English, there will be no simultaneous interpretation.



The "Master" Congress Centre is a new prestigious venue which makes it possible for the Novi Sad Fair to professionally organise different congresses, conferences, symposia, seminars, promotions, presentations, corporate events, fashion shows and similar gatherings. Business people can obtain services which meet the standards of European congress centres, all in one place.

The large congress hall and six smaller ones, with state-of-the-art equipment, cover an area of 2,230 m2 and can be joined into one hall for the purpose of bigger events.
